Drumming - Playing Requirements



1. Event 14 - **Two parts** March tempo of any time signature
2. Events 15, 16, & 20 - **Four parts** March tempo of any time signature
3. Event 21 - **Four parts** March tempo of any time signature
4. Event 17, 18, 19, 22 & 23 – Min. of 4 parts each

Drumming - Rules

1. Competitors will only be allowed to compete in their own age group.
2. Age will be that on the day of the actual competition.
3. No geographical restrictions apply.
4. Events 14 is confined to players who are not experienced performers and have not won= 1st place in a Pad competition or competed with a pipe band in competition prior to= 15th September 2023.
5. Event 15 is confined to players who have not been placed 1st in a Novice drumming= competition prior to 15th September 2023. They may not play in any snare drumming= class.
6. Event 20 is confined to players who have not placed first in a novice tenor drumming competition, they may play up to event 21 but no other Tenor drumming event
7. 1 or 2 Pipers should accompany competitors in Events 15, 16, 17, 18 & 19.
8. Competitors in Events 20, 21, 22 & 23 should be accompanied by 1 or 2 Pipers and 1= Snare Drummer.
9. All trophies must be signed for and returned 1 month prior to competition unless by= prior arrangement with the committee. Failure to return trophies in time may result in= competitors being excluded from competition.
10. The judge' s decisions are final.
11. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for loss or damage to any=property belonging to the competitors or members of the public.
12. For all events played on the Dr um, competitors should be in highland dress including= jacket or waistcoat, tie, bonnet or Glengarry and appropriate footwear if issued. These= should be also worn for the prize giving.
13. Competitors must be ready to compete in accordance with the published order of play
14. Tuning rooms and grounds are to be kept tidy at all times.
15. All competitors must agree to be bound by these rules and entry requirements.

Other Information

1. Payment of £5 per event to be sent via bank transfer on same day as entry with name as reference account details on page 1.
2. Playing requirements and rules will be on display, at the venue, on the day of competition.
3. The draw will be available to view on **The City of Brechin Pipe Band** Facebook page.

5. Entry fee of £4 per spectator.
6. Canteen facilities will be available on the day.
